

Garden & Landscape Diagnostic Clinic

The Texas AgriLife Extension Service will conduct a free garden and landscape diagnostic clinic from 8 am-1 pm, Thursday, July 22nd at the Terrell County Community building.

The Texas Department of Agriculture will offer three general continuing education units for private applicator license holders.
